WEEKLY PRAYER FOCUS

Wk 40 : 2nd -8th October 2011.

Thank God for Nigeria's 51st Independence Anniversary. Earnestly confess the sins of the people and plead with God to have mercy over His heritage. Thank God for the successes and failures of the past years and the new wave of revival in the land (Pr 14:34). Pray that the Kingdom of God shall be entrenched in Nigeria and His Will shall be done in every home, business place and community as the light of the gospel illuminates and overthrows the pervasive darkness in the land. (John 1:5,9).

Pray for the South West Regional Convention holding in Oshogbo between 6th -8th October 2011. Pray for a rich harvest of genuinely converted souls and spiritual upliftment of all attendees. Pray that the fruit of this convention shall abide (John 15:16).

Ask God to ignite a fresh fire of revival in the host city - that the convention will bring unsurpassed increase to the kingdom of God in Oshogbo (Acts 6:7). Pray for journey mercies, clement weather and surplus provisions.

Wk 41: 9th -15th October 2011.

Ask for Grace and mercy of the Lord upon Arc Ifeanyi Odedo and other leaders of the Fellowship in Nigeria as they stand in the forefront of the battle for the souls of men. (2Thes 3:1; Heb13:18;) Pray that their hands will be strong on the plough and their hearts will not fail as they wade through the turbulence of the current impasse (luke 9:62; Eph 3:16) . Pray that every weak hand be strengthened with grace, and every feeble knee be rejuvenated with fresh life to the end that the Fellowship will march from strength to strength in spite of the antics of the devil and the contradictions of men (Heb 12:12-13, 2Tim 4:17).

Pray for President Goodluck Jonathan and his cabinet asking God to grant them courage, boldness, wisdom and grace to lead Nigeria into the blessings of her jubilee. Pray that as Nigeria steps into her first year after the jubilee celebration, she shall experience rest from all which had troubled her peace and wellbeing since independence (Heb 4:9; Is 60:22).

Week 42: 16th -22nd October 2011.

Pray for the International President, Mr. Richard Shakarian and members of the International Executive. Ask the Lord to bless them and grant them the grace, strength and wisdom to lead the Fellowship aright in these difficult times (1Tim2:1-2). Pray for God's intervention in resolving the impasse between the International office and some nations in the FGBMFI family. Pray that the proposed International Prayer Summit scheduled to hold early next year will provide a platform to seek the face of the Lord for genuine repentance, mercy, reconciliation and refocusing of the Fellowship to the vision revealed by God through Demos Shakarian (Rom 12:8; Eph 4:3-6; Heb 12:14; 2Cor 5:18-20).

Pray that the South South Regional Convention holding between 20th-22nd October 2011 in Benin City shall bring all attendees into their season of change. Pray for open heavens: that the Word of the Lord shall come with great power to save, heal, deliver and transform. Pray that Benin city will never be the same again. Pray that all the set targets and expectations (spiritual, financial etc) concerning the convention shall be surpassed. (Eph 3:20).

Week 43: 23rd- 29th October 2011.

Thank God for the strategic role committed to FGBMFI in the transformation of Nigeria and pray that the Lord will prepare and mobilise every member to take personal responsibility for the establishment of the Kingdom of God in his/her marketplace. Pray that each member will purposefully use the talents received from the Lord to bring profit to the kingdom of God in the marketplace (2Cor 5:15; Luke19:13). Pray that God will dislodge all the spiritual cobwebs and entanglements which had crippled Nigeria's growth and blurred her vision over the years (Amos 4:1-3). Pray that righteousness, justice and peace shall reign in the land (Prov 21:3; Eccle 5:8; Amos 5:24).

Week 44: 30th October - 5th November 2011.

“...GO and make disciples of all Nations... (Matt 28:19). Pray for grace for focused obedience to the last command of Jesus Christ.

All the grace, mercy, deliverance, security, miracles and other provisions received from the Lord are for this critical purpose pray that the investments of heaven over your life and other members of the Fellowship shall not be in vain (1Cor 15:9-10). Pray that the body of Christ and anyone who comes into contact with you shall profit from the grace of God upon your life (1Cor 12:7 2Cor 9:12-15; Acts 10:38).

Pray for the success of the South East Regional Convention holding between 3rd 5th November 2011. Ask God for open heavens and a mighty outpouring of His power. Ask that all attendees will experience a new wave of revival and the host city will never be the same again. Pray that needs (spiritual, marital, business etc) will be supplied with great abundance (Acts 2:37; Phil 4:19).

Week 45: 6th - 12th November 2011.

.... of all Nations...(Matt 28:19) The Vision is worldwide - Pray for the International Outreach of the Fellowship which is targeted at all souls on earth because Christ already paid the price for all. (2Cor 5:14, Romans 5:18-19). Thank God for the successes recorded till date in the Airlifts to the nations and ask the Lord to open new horizons (Psalm 2:8). Pray that God will recruit more labourers into His harvest and revitalize the work. (Matt 9:37-38).

Until we **GO** the signs will not follow (Mark 16:15-18), and the Lord will not work to confirm His **Word** (Mark 16:20) : Ask God to release you from what has tied you and hindered you from **going** to continue Christ's mission on earth (Luke 19:10; 2Tim2:3-4; 2Cor 5:9)

Ask the Lord to mobilize our members out of the seat of ignorance, complacency and disillusionment and set a fresh fire of passion for lost souls in our bones so that we can promptly **Go** for Him in season and out of season. (Prov 24:11-12; 1Cor 9:16).

Only disciples can make disciples: Ask God for grace to abide in Him, that he might incubate and transform you into his disciple (John 15:1-5; 8:31-32; Luke 9:23; Matt 4:19).

Week 46: 13th -19th November 2011.

GO, DO. Every member of the Fellowship is a stakeholder in the mission of the Fellowship. Ask God to reveal to you and grant wisdom to focus on the portion of the labour in FGBMFI assigned to you and to complete it. (Song of Solomon 1:6; John 4:34; Acts 20:24).

Pray that the Lord will equip you and grant you grace to give Him the space needed for Him to carry out His purpose through you. (John 5:19; Phil 2:13; Eph 2:10; Is 49:2). Ask the Lord to ignite your heart afresh with the vision for bringing dead men to life through simple testimonies empowered by the Holy Spirit (2Tim 4:5).

Pray for the ministry of the church in reaching the unsaved. Pray for church leaders and ask God to unite them as he breaks all denominational barriers and other distractions used by the devil to partition the church (Col 3:11). Pray for revival unto holiness and righteousness in the church, that she would be able to take the battle to the enemy and the gates of hell shall not prevail against her (Matt 16:18-19).

Week 47: 20th -26th November 2011.

“ The Vision is not complete. The Vision intensifies” : Pray for peace and harmony within FGBMFI worldwide, that the Fellowship be not distracted from the mission of reconciling men back to God, as there is still much territory to be conquered (Joshua 13:1). Pray for reconciliation between Nigeria and the International asking God to intervene in the impasse and cause what the devil meant for evil to turn out for the good of the Fellowship (1Pet3:8-9; Is 54:17).

Ask God to bring back all who have withdrawn from the Fellowship as a result of the impasse, that they may again join their brethren in **“breaking the chains of the devil and setting the captives free”** (Heb 10:25;)

Ask God to forgive the Sins of our nation, especially the shedding of innocent blood through assassinations, kidnappings, bombings etc.

Pray for all the Ministers, Legislators, Governors and Local Government Chairmen, Justices, Judges and Magistrates. Ask that the fear of the Lord will govern their hearts in all that they do or say to the benefit of the people (Is 32:1-5; 33:1-2; Prov 29:2; Prov 9:10, 8:13).

Week 48: 27th November -3rd December 2011.

Manifestation of His glory must begin from the home. Pray for the families of the members of the Fellowship; that the abuse of the marriage institution will not be the cause of many believers losing their salvation. (Malachi 2:14; Peter 3:7). Ask God to heal every broken, ailing or depressed home and restore sweetness, peace, harmony and marital fulfillment. (Phil 1:9-11; Eph 5:33). Pull down all the walls of conflict and disharmony that the enemy has erected to partition our homes (Matt 15:13). Pray that the Lord will guide the unmarried in making the right choices. (Ps 32:8-9; Rom8:14; John 16:13). Pray that the Lord will remember all who are trusting him for the fruit of the womb (Gen 30:22).

Pray that our children will not be the cause of our disqualification from divine service. (1Sam 2:29-36, 8:1-5). Ask God to shield them from the pervasive deception of the devil through the world system and unwholesome peer pressure so that they may indeed be the Godly seed that God intended them to be. (Mal. 2:15; Ps 127:3-5).

Week 49: 4th 10th December 2011.

Thank God for the rapid growth being experienced in the Fellowship in Nigeria. Praise the Lord for the realization of set targets and objectives and ask Him to renew members' zeal and commitment to the Vision. Pray for the new chapters under the leadership of new officers: Pray that God's hand shall be strong upon their lives and that they will be strengthened with grace in the inner man that they may know and experience the power of God in a progressive manner (Phil 1:17-18, 3:16-19; Colossians 1:9-12). Pray that none of the new chapters will die young, rather they shall be strong and fruitful.

Ask the Lord to revive all weak, ailing and dead chapters. Prophecy that they shall rise again as a mighty army with the injection of new lease of life from the Lord. (Ezek 37:7-10).

Pray for the needs of all FGBMFI members entrusting them unto God's nurture and care. Ask God to bless their homes, businesses and all their endeavours according to his riches in glory (Is 43:18-19; Phil 4:19).

Week 50: 11th -17th December 2011.

Pray for the Ladies of the Fellowship thanking God for the great supportive roles they play in the lives of their husbands and the ministry of the Fellowship in general. Ask God to reward all their labour of love and bless all that they lay their hands upon to do (1Cor 15:58).

Decree that the tokens of diviners and the counsel of the ungodly over the lives of members of FGBMFI shall fail. (1 John 3:8). Agree with God that His will and counsel over our lives shall prosper. (Isaiah 55:8-13).

Pray for the peace and prosperity of Nigeria. Ask the Lord to groom and use the President and his cabinet members as His instrument of transforming Nigeria. Pray that all who carry a contrary agenda shall be cut off and replaced with credible men and women who fear God and love the people. (Is 56:1; Prov10:25-30).

Week 51: 18th- 24th December 2011.

Pray for the leadership of the six FGBMFI Regions in the country and the work committed into their hands. (1Timothy4:12-16; Col 1:28-29). Ask God to grant them grace to surmount all the peculiar challenges associated with the work of the Fellowship in the Regions (2Cor 12:9). Thank God for the success of all the Regional conventions and pray that the fruit will abide as they are effectively followed up (John 15:16).

Pray for all National Committees, FGBMFI Ministries (Fire Team, Media, New Generation Chapters, Prisons). Ask God to grant the chairmen and members of the committees the wisdom and grace to labour effectually in building the Fellowship up into a strong dynamic organism.(Eph 4:16).

Week 52: 25th- 31st December 2011.

Praise God for leading us successfully on the journey through 2011. Ask Him to teach you to number your days and apply your heart to His wisdom. Carefully assess your contribution to the kingdom of God and God's purpose in the earth in 2011 (Ps 90:12; Phil 1:20-21).

Thank God for all the bountiful blessings received in the course of the year and give Him praise for fighting all your battles and securing everlasting victory for you at the cross (Col 2:14-15; Prov 21:31).

Commit your way into the hands of the Master and pray that your life, in the coming year shall be fruitful, impactful and purposefully utilized for the establishment of the kingdom of God (Prov 3:3-5; Gal 2:20; Luke 11:2).

Praise God that the coming year shall usher in a new wave of revival in FGBMFI worldwide as the lord unfolds the new thing He is doing. Thank God for moving swiftly in His mighty power to end the lingering confusion and restoring all the lost glory.
